From Malaga Airport: -

It is pretty simple as after leaving airport you quickly pick up signs for Cordoba which take you most of the way but in details the instructions are as follows and please read so you take correct road when near to Almodovar Del Rio :

When leaving the airport follow signs to Malaga (N340), then once on the N340 follow signs to Motril / Antiquera A45 (as was the old N331) continue to follow signs for Cordoba / Seville on the A45.

From the A45 take the exit 16 "**Fernan Nunez**" (this is 144 kilometres from Malaga Airport).

Take direction **Seville** and then this road will meet the A-4 / E5 again sign posted to Cordoba or Seville, here you need to take the **Seville** turning (not Cordoba) and you then head for Seville (be careful when you get on this road as there is a very tight bend in the road) follow this road until you see turning for La Carlota & Posadas (exit 432) take this exit.

Then turn on road to Posadas (A445) take this road all the way over the bridge and through Posadas, once in town you take first right turn to the Main Rd (431) and then at end of rd take a right onto main road (431) to head for Cordoba.

You will pass **Hotel Maria** on left hand side drive under bridge and after take exit right (this is 2.4 kilometres from leaving Posadas) drive for about for about another 7 km and look out for orange signs " Circuito Motocross", these are the signs for the motocross track that you need to pass to get to us. Eventually these signs will get you to turn left off the (431) you actually have to do a right first and then cross back over rd (sign posted "de Alsine" and " Circuito Motocross"), this is 7 kilometres from Posadas. Follow this rd past the motocross track and drive for 3.5 kilometers and then turn left. Follow this dirt road until you come to our green gates on the left, drive through gates and bear right and again follow dirt road to the camp.

The town we are in is Almodovar del Rio and a castle overlooks it, which is a good landmark to look out for.



To Almudawar Hotel:

Turn right into town of Almodovar Del Rio. Drive down the hill and turn left at the disused Aquatic Park, drive down this hill and take the second road on the right. Drive up this road past some bars (Las Ninas / Salsa / Tavu / Pizza Victoria) and then drive past a coffee shop called Roldans on your right. You will come to a cross roads, here take a left and the Salones Joki Hostel is just on the left, drive down hill past this and stay left eventually you will come to a very steep road on your right, take this road and at end turn right and at the end of road the hotel is on the left corner. You can not turn left so turn right and park as soon as you find a space.

To Salones Joki:

Turn right into town of Almodovar Del Rio. Drive down the hill and turn left at the disused Aquatic Park, drive down this hill and take the second road on the right. Drive up this road past some bars (Over Differ / Pizza Victoria) and then drive past a coffee shop called Roldans on your right. You will come to a cross roads, here take a left and the hotel Salones Joki is just on the left there.

To Andres Flat:

Turn right into town of Almodovar Del Rio. Drive down the hill and turn left at the disused Aquatic Park (bins), drive down this hill and past the large modern brick building on right (school) and down past the medical centre on left (large modern building with a curved front) and after this take the next left. Drive straight on and you will see a furniture shop in front of you and Andres flat is above the shop; you will need to ring the first bell on the door to the right of the shop (when looking at it).

To Our House & Office:

Turn right into town of Almodovar Del Rio. Drive down the hill and turn left at the disused Aquatic Park, drive down this hill and take the second road on the right. Drive up this road past some bars (Over Differ / Pizza Victoria) and then drive past a coffee shop called Roldans on your right. You will come to a crossroads here take a right into "Calle Rosario" and we are just up on the left, number 5.

To San Luis:

As above but do not turn left towards lake, just continue on the 431 for approx 1.5 more kilometres and San Luis in on your left opposite the petrol station.

To Hotel Maria:



As said on above directions you will see hotel on left just after you turn on main rd from Posadas.

Important Info re driving in Spain:

The **maximum speed limit** on Spanish motorways is 120kph (75mph) but this will be **reduced from March 7th 2011 to 110kph (68mph)**. The government will rush to print new signs to alert people of the change. So please pay attention to the new law to avoid being fined as they do now send fines to your relevant country.

It is an offence here to drive without carrying your license and carries hefty cash fine; hence please carry your license at all times. There is a new system now whereby if you are caught speeding on camera then any appropriate fine payable will be sent directly to your home address, they are very hot on this now so be warned!
